

HELICOPTER SKYDIVE EIGER JUMP

Our most iconic skydive.

Scenic flight to the summit of the Eiger before jumping from ~14,500ft/4300m in front of the world-famous North Face.



Important Information

Registration: Please book here at www.skydiveinterlaken.com If you have a voucher please reserve your spot by email info@skydiveinterlaken.ch or telephone/WhatsApp on +41 79 588 90 00.

Weather/changes: Weather in the Alps is very unpredictable, and forecasts can be inaccurate. Therefore, if we have any doubts about the weather for your skydive then we will contact you the evening before your jump. If you do not hear from us, this is a good sign and we will meet as agreed. For safety reasons, a postponement can also be pronounced on site. We ask for your understanding. If you have any questions or uncertainties, you can always contact us by phone or e-mail. We understand that this experience is unique to every person, therefore we are very flexible in dealing with postponements.

Meeting time: Your registered time is also your arrival time whether you want to meet us at our dropzone, or you would like to be picked up. See below options.

Free on-site parking/Pick-up: If you would like to arrive on your own, our address is: Mittelweg 11, 3812 Wilderswil. 5 minutes by car from the centre of Interlaken. The pickups are from designated meeting points in Interlaken or Wilderswil (hotels and train stations). Due to numerous pickups with our van, we might be a little bit late - but we ask for your punctuality.

Duration: You should plan **2 to 3 hours** (depending on weather and group size).

Bring along: Comfortable clothing, suitable for the weather (gloves are recommended in winter) and closed shoes e.g. sneakers (no hiking boots). Drinks and small snacks (vending machine) can be bought on site. Spectators are very welcome, but please let us know in advance.

Registration/Payment: Besides filling out the registration/waiver form directly before your jump, you also have the possibility to book **photos and/or videos** (no pre-booking necessary). You can pay with credit card/EC or cash.

More flight time with Eiger PLUS: Fancy some additional helicopter flight time? Before your skydive (and in addition to the regular scenic flight), fly with the helicopter over the **Jungfrauoch "Top of Europe"** and the Sphinx Observatory and get an incredible view over the largest glacier in Europe - Aletsch glacier! For just CHF 150.- extra.

Introduction/Equipment: We provide you with obligatory safety instruction, and you will be equipped with a jumpsuit, harness and goggles.

Programme:

- Arrival at our office
- Fill out paperwork, get instructions and equipment
- **Drive to the Heli Base Gsteigwiler or Grindelwald:** The helicopter pad is located 5 minutes drive away from our office in Gsteigwiler. In case of weather, or for organisational reasons, the helicopter will occasionally pick us up directly from Grindelwald (approx 20-minute drive in our van).
- **Scenic flight:** A helicopter flight of about 10 to 15 minutes awaits you, above Grindelwald and to the summit of the Eiger.
- **Freefall:** The freefall takes up to 45 seconds (depending on weight and size).
- **Parchuteride:** After the parachute opens at 1'500m above ground, you have about 8 minutes to enjoy the view before landing safely on the landing field in Grindelwald.
- **The return journey to Wilderswil:** After landing, we take the van back to our office – duration approx. 20 minutes.
- **Photos/Video:** You will receive your personal video and/or photos about 10 minutes after returning to our office. You can then watch your movie on the big screen.
- **Return transport:** The return transport is free of charge. Please note that we try to bring the whole group back together. We thank you for your patience.

Things to know:

The basic requirement for a parachute jump is good physical condition. Skydive Interlaken reserves the right to refuse to allow a client to make a jump if there are safety concerns, even if the limits described below are respected.

Maximum height of the guest: 195cm / 76'

Maximum weight of the guest: 100 kg / 220 lbs

Age: Under 18 years we need the consent of the parents, there is no upper age limit in good health.

Children: Skydiving with children/young people is basically no problem, as long as they made the decision themselves. In addition, the children/young people should be big enough for the harness (this is usually from about 12 years).

Availability:

- The Eiger Jump is available all year round (depending on the weather)
- The best time to jump is from October to April, as the cold air provides the clearest views
- During peak season (May to September) we can only offer the Eiger Jump on weekdays or at off-peak times (usually after 3 pm) on the weekends.

Infrastructure:

- Wifi
- Free access to a computer
- Free parking spaces
- Beer, tea, coffee and vending machine snacks
- Comfortable area to chill, toys for children
- Souvenirs such as T-shirts, long sleeves and hoodies
- Toilets
